• **Luke 10:20-37**

20 "Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are recorded in heaven."

21 At that very time He rejoiced greatly in the Holy Spirit, and said, "I praise You, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and intelligent and have revealed them to infants. Yes, Father, for this way was well-pleasing in Your sight.

33 "But a Samaritan, who was on a journey, came upon him; and when he saw him, he felt compassion,

34 and came to him and bandaged up his wounds, pouring oil and wine on them; and he put him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn and took care of him.

35 "On the next day he took out two denarii and gave them to the innkeeper and said, 'Take care of him; and whatever more you spend, when I return I will repay you.'

36 "Which of these three do you think proved to be a neighbor to the man who fell into the robbers' hands?"

37 And he said, "The one who showed mercy toward him." Then Jesus said to him, "Go and do the same."

* **“Comfort”**

• **2 Corinthians 1:3-7**

3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort,

4 who comforts us in all our affliction so that we will be able to comfort those who are in any affliction with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.

5 For just as the sufferings of Christ are ours in abundance, so also our comfort is abundant through Christ.

6 But if we are afflicted, it is for your comfort and salvation; or if we are comforted, it is for your comfort, which is effective in the patient enduring of the same sufferings which we also suffer;

7 and our hope for you is firmly grounded, knowing that as you are sharers of our sufferings, so also you are sharers of our comfort.

41 Moved with compassion, Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed."

brokenhearted,
To proclaim liberty to captives

36 "For the LORD will vindicate His
people,
And will have compassion on His
servants,
When He sees that their strength is
gone,
And there is none remaining, bond
or free

¹³ But we do not want you to be
uninformed, brothers *and sisters*, about
those who **U**are asleep, so that you will not
grieve as indeed the rest *of mankind do*,
who have no hope. ¹⁴ For if we believe that
Jesus died and rose *from the dead*, so also
God will bring with Him those who have
fallen asleep **k**through Jesus. ¹⁵ For we say
this to you by the word of the Lord, that
we who are alive **U**and remain until the
coming of the Lord will not precede those
who have fallen asleep. ¹⁶ For the Lord

Himself will descend from heaven with a
Ushout, with the voice of *the* archangel
and with the trumpet of God, and the dead
in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷ Then we who are
alive, who remain, will be caught up
together with them in the clouds to meet
the Lord in the air, and so we will always
be with the Lord. ¹⁸ Therefore, **U**comfort
one another with these words.

• **Philippians 2:1-2**

1 Therefore if there is any encouragement in
Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if
there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any
affection and compassion,
2 make my joy complete by being of the same
mind, maintaining the same love, united in
spirit, intent on one purpose.

• **Colossians 3:12**

12 So, as those who have been chosen of
God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of
compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness
and patience;

7 for this reason, brethren, in all our distress

• **2 Thessalonians 2:16, 17**

¹³ But we should always give thanks to God for you, brothers *and sisters* beloved by the Lord, because God has chosen you ^[r]from the beginning for salvation ^[s]through sanctification ^[u]by the Spirit and faith in the truth. ¹⁴ It was for this He called you through our gospel, ^[u]that you may obtain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. ¹⁵ So then, brothers *and sisters*, stand firm and hold on to the traditions which you were taught, whether by word *of mouth* or by letter ^[v]from us.

¹⁶ Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who has loved us and given us eternal comfort and good hope by grace, ¹⁷ comfort and strengthen your hearts in every good work and word.

⁷ For I have come to have much joy and comfort in your love, because the hearts of

the saints have been refreshed through you, brother.
